## ORDER

The Court, being fully informed, finds that the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives stationed at the Boise Field Office (ATF-Boise Field Office), in the exercise of their official duties and powers, have a need to examine on a regular basis information accessible through the Idaho Supreme Court iCourt Portal to support their responsibility of providing law enforcement services throughout the state.


Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, pursuant to the authority granted to the Chief Justice under Rule 32(c)(1) of the Idaho Court Administrative Rules that the ATF- Boise Field Office shall have "LEA Access" to court records as provided in Paragraph F of Exhibit 1 of the April 11, 2016, Order In Re: Extended Access.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Director of the Courts may temporarily suspend the extended access granted by this order, subject to review by the Chief Justice, which may result in the subsequent revocation of such extended access by the Chief Justice or reinstatement of such access subject to terms and conditions necessary to prevent unauthorized disclosure of information exempt from public disclosure.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the effective date of this order shall be December 22, 2025.
